Description: The Fund Development Volunteer contributes to the success of our fundraising events throughout the year. Plan and coordinate in collaboration with staff, board members, other volunteers and community members. Fundraising events are designed to raise funds for and promote community awareness of Victim Support Services.

Essential Position Functions:

- Identify event sponsors for potential enhanced or increased partnership opportunities

- Promote event in-person, via email, social media and cold-calling to gain exposure and potential attendees
- Assist with publications and marketing materials
- Send out correspondence including but not limited to thank you cards
- Volunteer the day of event

Location and Time Commitment: Fund Development Volunteers work remotely with occasional, limited in-person services with the discretion of Supervisor at Administration Office in Everett, WA and/or other designated location as agreed upon in the region assigned to. Time and hours each week are flexible depending upon the volunteer's needs and preferences.

Minimum Requirements: Successfully complete application and/or resume, complete interview, criminal background check, able to maintain strict standards of confidentiality, must have access to computer, email, internet and cell phone. Creative thinker, solutions-oriented, strong communication skills, relationships with vendors and potential sponsors is a plus, ability to work in a collaborative, fast-paced environment, ability to multi-task and to take direction and work independently.
