In western society, there has been untold amounts of money spent to deal primarily with perpetrators of crime. Tragically, however, far too many citizens who become victims of crime are left isolated in crime's wake, fending for themselves and struggling with scars both visible and invisible. In the aftermath of crime, there is shock and devastation, pain, fear and trauma. There is confusion about what is happening in the moment, and what is to come in the future. The lives of victims of crime, and those of victims' families, are irreparably damaged after a crime has been committed against them. Many survivors take years to recover, whether physically from their injuries, or coming to terms with their losses, and many remain deeply traumatized.

Yet there is also a path of help, of hope and of healing that is paved each and every time someone reaches out to help a victim of crime, and to provide support to someone who is hurting. There is a path of justice that results from the simple act of service to victims and survivors of crime. This is why Victim Support Services was formed over 47 years ago, with a mission to support and advocate for crime victims and their loved ones – promoting their rights and assisting with their needs; walking with them through every step of the judicial process following a criminal act.

VSS PROGRAMS

Direct Services

VSS has been providing peer support and advocacy for victims of crime since 1975. We are the oldest victim advocacy agency in Washington state and one of the oldest in the nation, and continue to provide services free of charge to victims of crime. Advocacy services include crisis intervention, emotional support, information on victimization and victim rights, assistance with crime victim compensation application and victim impact statements, courtroom support, emergency financial assistance, safety planning, funeral arrangements, media intervention, referrals, and more.

Davie our Facility Dog

Davie is a professionally trained assistance dog. Suitable for providing quiet companionship to individuals in legal settings without causing any disruption of the proceedings. As legally neutral companions for victims and witnesses during the investigation and prosecution of crimes, Davie helps individuals feel willing and able to describe what happened and also provide emotional support. Davie can also assist with police interviews, counseling appointments, and any other situation that provides support to crime victims and their loved ones.

Core Academy Training

Core Academy Training is integral to providing direct services to individuals hurt or harmed by crime. This 40-hour training qualifies participants to provide direct services to victims in Washington State. Victim Support Services provides this essential training multiple times a year. Those that successfully complete Core have the opportunity to apply to be a nationally credentialed advocate.


